ARGENTINA, known for its World Cup Soccer teams and prize beef, has a culture and people of European and Latin origin. Greater Buenos Aires, the capital city, has a population of 12 million. Spiritism is strong and growing.



CHILE is a land of 14 million people nestled between the south Pacific Ocean and the Andes Mountains, whose climate varies from extreme desert to rain forest. Its people



are of diverse ethnic origins, primarily native Indians and Europeans. Many islanders remain unreached.

URUGUAY's extensive grazing land provides for cattle and sheep. Reforestation is progressing in this small Atlantic republic of European decent (including many Russians). Uruguay's four million people are largely indifferent to the Gospel. Evangelical church growth has been very slow, a challenge to missionaries.

Summer internship: ❖ One to three months ministering with missionaries and nationals in South America. ❖ Provides exposure to the language, people, culture, living conditions, food and value system - as required for the completion of some mission courses in Bible colleges and universities.



Exposure to Missions

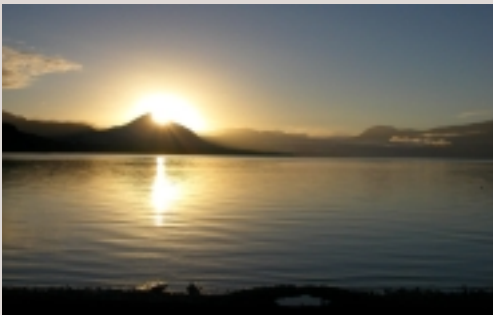

Internships

Extensive Internship: ❖ One to two years in South America. ❖ Active involvement with experienced missionaries and nationals engaged in evangelism and establishing local churches.

WHAT'S THE GAME PLAN?

Our Internships are envisioned as on-the-job training. Participants will not only observe missions in action, but will be very actively involved in the task under the direction of experienced missionaries. This will require wholehearted devotion to Jesus Christ as LORD. There will be hard work, much of it menial in nature. It will cover a wide variety of activity such as: music, secretarial, construction, maintenance, camp work, Bible Institute, youth programs,



DVBS, evangelism, and teaching MK's.

"TIM" involves traveling and seeing new and possibly strange things, but you will not be going as a "tourist". There is a task to be done. As you go with the desire to serve, to learn, to grow and be stretched, you can count on the faithfulness of the Lord Who said, "*..lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.*" Done in this spirit, the field experience will be rewarding and meaningful!



WHAT DOES "TIM" COST?

Our programs require the applicant to have a round-trip air ticket to their country of ministry. Ticket prices may vary, depending on the length of stay, from \$500.00 to \$900.00 when leaving from Miami. Our Internship Programs require the assurance of \$450.00 per month for living and travel expenses while on the Field.
