We are not exactly sure, but we expect that we will be in the US for the next two years completing Nadia's citizenship papers and raising the extra support that we need in order to come back to the field.

NADIA AND I have enjoyed the opportunity to serve with Pastor IGUAZÚ RODRÍGUEZ and his family for the last eight months.

We have been able to teach and be involved with the teens, both of us have been able to teach Sunday school, and Bobby has been able to lead different services and teach on a regular basis on Wednesday's and Sundays.

We covet your prayers for this small local church, that they would stay faithful to God's Word and always strive to be generous to their new Pastor.

As we leave the church, we continue praying for these people to whom God has allowed us to invest in their lives in different ways.
